## 2024 Election Dates

Primary: August 20, 2024  
General: November 5, 2024

## How To Vote

- **On Election Day**
  - You **MUST** vote at your designated precinct.
- **Early Voting**
  - **October 26 - November 2**
  - Check your local Supervisor of Elections website for voting locations and times.
- **Vote by Mail**
  - Request a mail-in ballot by October 24.
  - Ballots must be received by 7 pm on election day.
