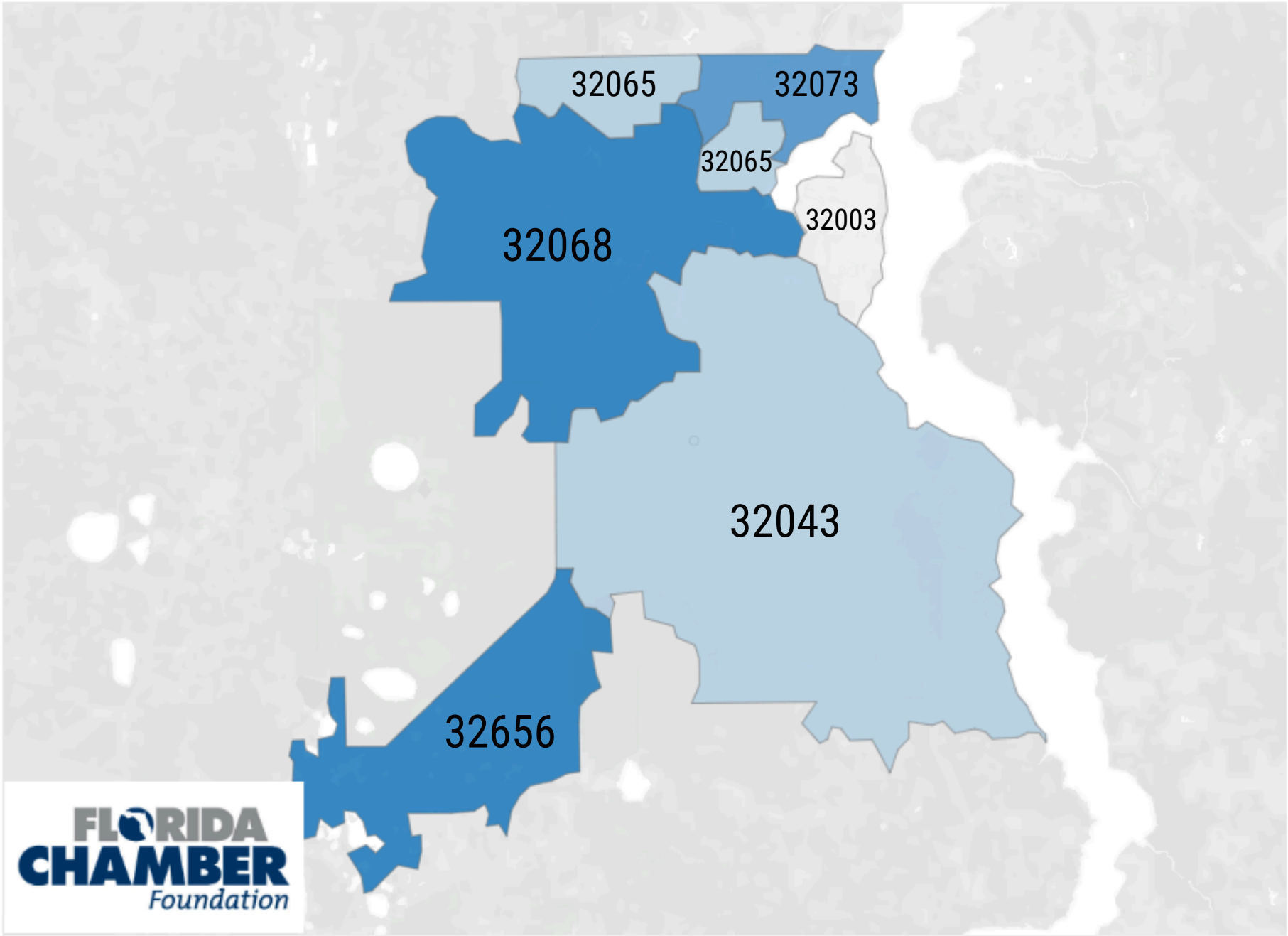

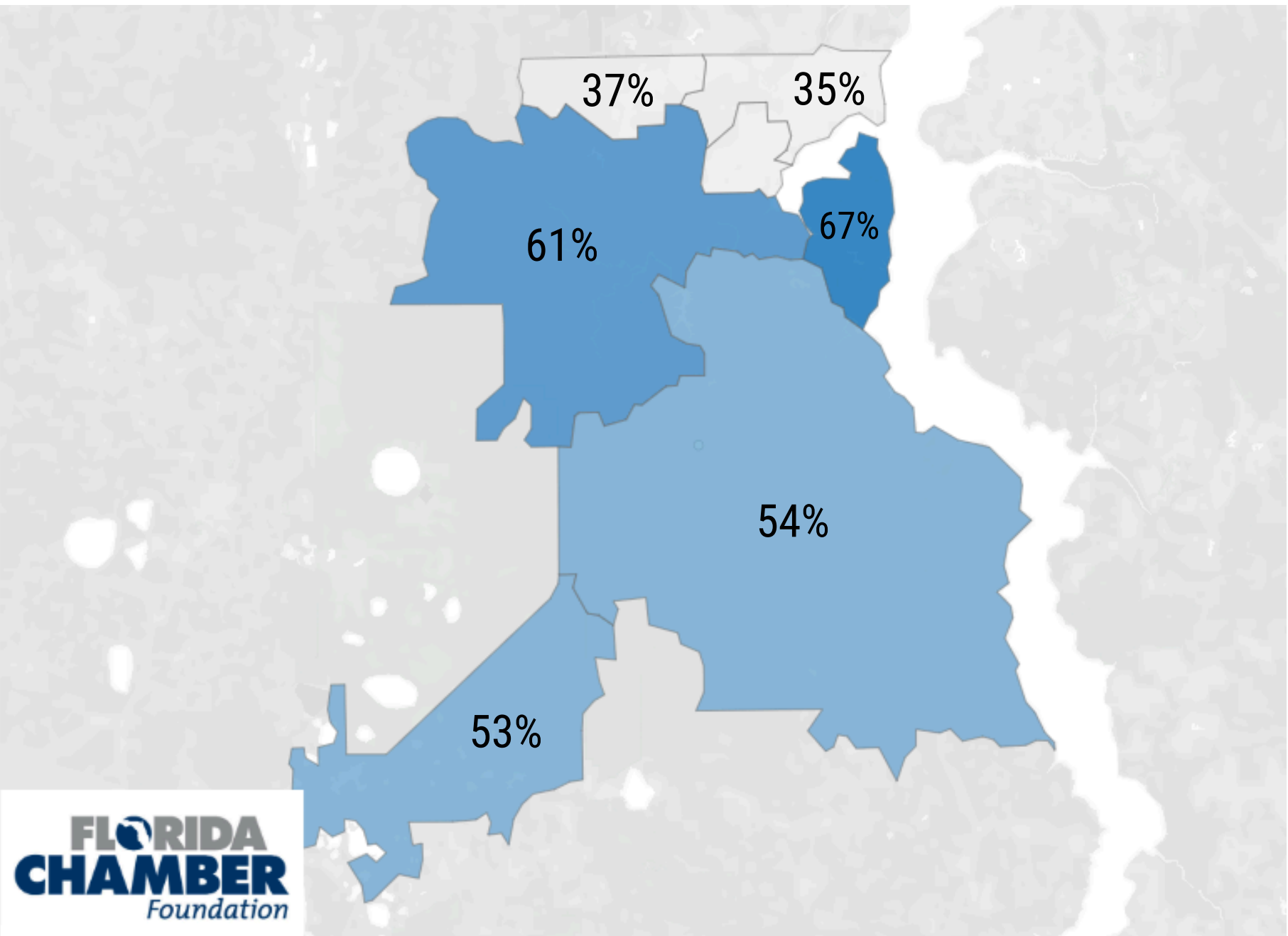


Diving Into the Zip Code Level


