What the Research Shows...

Studies indicate that early learning experiences play a crucial role in brain development.

Data also supports the idea that prioritizing high-quality and meaningful early experiences is more effective than addressing behavioral or academic issues later with older children.

Benefits to children with a more stable early learning wokforce include:

- Deepened teacher knowledge of individual children
- Increased teacher understanding of child development
- Smoother developmental progress and more secure attachments for children
- Ease in transition to elementary school (kindergarten readiness)

Economists estimate a return of \$4-\$12 for every \$1 spent on early childhood education



What the Research Shows...

Average weekly wages for the child care services sector were **54** percent below the national average for weekly wages in the third quarter of 2023 (\$609 compared to \$1,328).

Child care workers are more likely than workers in other industries to fall below the poverty line.

Attracting and retaining qualified staff has become increasing difficult throughout the child care sector.

"Addressing the need for affordable, accessible, reliable, and high-quality child care requires ensuring a well-compensated, well-supported child care workforce."

Continuing Education & Lifelong Learning for Our State's ECE Workforce

The TEACH Early Childhood® Scholarship program can assist with workforce development and help address many areas of concern for young children. TEACH works to ensure that our state's early learning and family child care educators have access to:

- high-level training and professional learning opportunities
- a more affordable and attainable college education
- increased compensation for their work
- attractive options and incentives to remain within the early learning profession

TEACH is funded by the Florida Division of Early Learning and was awarded \$17 million for FY 2024-25

(increase from \$11.1 M in FY 2023-24)



What is TEACH?

The TEACH Early Childhood[®] Scholarship Program works in partnership with educators and their employers to cover the majority of the costs for tuition, books, and other educational expenses.

Scholarships include early learning credentials and renewals, college credits and certificates, and degrees in ECE or related fields.

Who is Eligible?

Teachers, directors, owners, or family child care educators may be eligible if they:

- Have a high school diploma (regionally accredited) or GED
- Are employed by a licensed, license-exempt, or registered program in Florida (*ex. child care facilities, family child care homes, and out-of-school-time programs*)
- Work or volunteer a minimum of 20 hours a week with young children, birth through Pre-K *(at least 520 hours per year)*
- Have the support and sponsorship of their employer

What Does TEACH Provide Scholars and Their Sponsoring Centers/ **Programs?**

What Does TEACH Provide Scholars and Their Sponsoring Centers/ Programs?

Technology Reimbursement*

Computer/laptop reimbursement for active scholars (90% reimbursed, up to \$500 claim)

Release Time & Reimbursement*

- Scholars receive 3 hours of paid release time each week to attend classes, focus on their studies, or complete projects/assignments
- Sponsors receive a paid release time reimbursement equal to FL minimum wage + \$2.00/hr (Will be \$15.00 for FY 2024-25)

Counselor

Dedicated TEACH Counselor to provide **academic**, **career pathway**, and **administrative support**




